Pharmacy Technician Program (upon
graduation and completion of a
nationally approved certification test,
you will be eligible to register as a
Pharmacy Technician with the ND
State Board of Pharmacy)
- Or, participate in an ASHP approved
Pharmacy Technician-in-Training
program (once enrolled, you must
register with the ND State Board of
Pharmacy as a Pharmacy Technician-
in-Training)
